Outward Bound Trip, Monday 5 December 2022 - Friday 9 December 2022

Students should arrive at school **no later than 08:40 on Monday 5 December 2022**, drop their bags off in the main hall and then go to form until 09:10. They will then return to the hall to collect their bags and go to their coaches.

As a reminder, students should bring with them on Monday 5 December 2022:

- a packed lunch and a drink (please do not pack any food with nuts)
- a deposit of £10.00 cash for the use of the specialist equipment at the centre which will be refunded at the end of the week if students return all equipment
- any medication they will require during the week onto the coach and not packed into their luggage.

All students will return to St Aidan's on Friday 9 December 2022 at approximately **15:00-15:30**, traffic permitting. It may be possible for students to get the school bus if required but this cannot be guaranteed if we are delayed. Please remember that mobile phones are **not allowed** on this trip.



YOUR OUTWARD BOUND EXPERIENCE

During your stay, you will have to take responsibility for your daily life, respecting those living alongside you, making your bed, tidying your room, looking after your belongings and those of the Centre

The Centre will provide you with all specialist activity and safety equipment (please bring a refundable £10.00 deposit with you as this is required on arrival). However, you are welcome to bring your own kit and use it, providing it meets the Centre's safety standards. You will need to bring personal clothing and footwear.

CLOTHING CHECK LIST BED LINEN IS PROVIDED BUT PLEASE SUPPLY YOUR OWN TOWELS

- Casual T-shirts
- Sweatshirts
- Thermal Tops
- Jumpers

- Synthetic trousers for walking (not jeans)

- Prescribed medicate (where necessary)

All courses may involve getting wet at some point, so please make sure you have plenty of spare dry clothes to change into.

MONEY

You will only need to bring a small amount of money, as the course is fully inclusive. All centres do have a shop, which sells confectionery, souvenirs, and some items of clothing. We advise £15.00 per week, plus the £10.00 refundable deposit of equipment.
