## **Great Yorkshire Show**

Next Tuesday 9th July, years 7, 8 and 9 will visit the Great Yorkshire Show. Students will go to form as usual and collect their GYS wristband which will be required for entry to the show and needs to be worn all day. They will then meet their Head of Year who will remind them about conduct and behaviour and provide them with information for the day.

We will walk down to the showground at 9.00am and return in time for the school buses at 3-30pm.

Students should bring a packed lunch and a drink or alternatively some money to buy food at the showground. Those who receive free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch by their Head of Year. Please can you ensure that students wear suitable clothing in case of inclement weather and a waterproof jacket and suncream which may be kept in their bags.

Students will be required to stay in groups of 3-5 and must not go around the showground on their own. If for some reason they find themselves on their own, they should make their way back to the staff area or call school on 01423 885814.

Students are reminded that BB guns, fireworks, knives, toy/replica guns etc. should not be bought whilst at the show - **if unsure do not buy it!** 

We would be grateful if parents do not ask members of staff to release students to go home early or to join them at the show. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Those students requiring medication including inhalers for asthma and epipens must bring them for the day. We ill not be able to release students from school to go to the show unless they have the correct medication with them.

We would be very grateful if you could do the following in preparation for Tuesday's outing:

1. Please can you take your child through the essential information attached so they are aware of the do's and don'ts. We will also reinforce these in school.
