Exam Results Year 12 and Year 13

Please note if you are unable to collect your results in person on **Thursday 15 August** (Level 3 Results, i.e. A Levels/BTEC) or **Thursday 22 August** (GCSE Results) and you wish to nominate someone else to collect them on your behalf, you should e-mail Mrs Humphrey (w.humphrey@staidans.co.uk) your authority for us to release your results and to whom. Alternatively, you can leave a large stamped addressed envelope with the correct postage on, in the Sixth Form Office, **before 19 July**. Unfortunately, we are only able to e-mail results to students in exceptional circumstances on results day.

Post-Results Information (Request forms/Fees applicable and Deadline dates)

These will be available on the SA and SJF school websites ahead of results day for any students who sat exams this summer to use once results are published on **15 August**. The 3 main post results deadlines for A Levels/other Level 3 exams that students need to be aware of are:

- **22 August** – Priority Review of Marking (for students with a place at their chosen University dependent on a grade change)
- **29 August** – Priority Return of a copy of your exam paper/script (to help students decide whether they wish to get an exam paper reviewed)
- **26 September** – Review of Marking

REMINDER: Year 13 – access to your school email address after September 2024

It is school policy school that student email addresses and all linked files/Teams accounts are deleted at the end of September after a student has left school. It will not be possible after you have left to access any of the work on your school account, once it has been deleted. **Please save anything that you may need in the future to your personal account so you do not lose it.**
