Following the successful completion of the training weekend, the next stage is the assessed expedition.

Participants need to be dropped off at the **Darley Memorial Hall in Darley** on Saturday morning between 09:45 and 10:00. They will need to be collected from there on Sunday. Please be on standby from 14:00, but we will advise students to contact you when they are approximately one hour from their finish point.

DUKE OF EDINBURGH BRONZE AWARD – Assessed Expedition

- (i) I agree to my child taking part in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award activities and understand what this involves.
- (ii) I understand that the staff responsible for the expedition will take all reasonable care of participants.
- (iii) I consent to any emergency treatment necessary. I therefore authorise BXM Expeditions staff to sign, on my behalf, any written form of consent required by the hospital authorities should medical treatment (a surgical operation or injection) be deemed necessary. Provided that the delay required to obtain my signature might be considered, in the opinion of the doctor or surgeon concerned, likely to endanger my child's health or safety.
- (iv) I confirm that school will be notified of any changes to the medical/emergency contact details provided earlier this year.

Itinerary

Saturday

- Students to be dropped off between 09:45 and 10:00am at the start point please.
- Groups will be issued with group kit and will set off at their allotted time.

- Groups will navigate and be remotely supervised by an instructor who will meet them at agreed points.
- Students will arrive at the campsite where they will cook and camp.
- BXM and St Aidan's Staff will be camping on site.

Sunday

- Students will prepare breakfast, pack up and depart from 08:00am.
- Students will walk unaccompanied; staff will remotely supervise and meet groups at points throughout the day.
- Pupils will be asked to contact home approximately one hour before they expect to arrive at their finish location, but please be on standby from 14:00.

Notes

- Pupils are required to bring with them enough food for lunch on both days, breakfast and an evening meal that they must cook. They have decided in their groups what they will need. They are not allowed to buy food during the day. Water will be available on the campsite and if necessary from staff throughout the day.
- Pupils have been provided with a suggested kit list on the BXM website. They should ensure that they have everything they need.
- Pupils will be camping where other groups and the public will also be staying, so suitable behaviour goes without saying.

- If pupils need to borrow any kit for their expedition, such as a rucksack or waterproofs, this must be ordered prior to the expedition. Please come and see Mr Holdsworth for a kit booking form. Kit can then be collected from B16 on Thursday 19th September 15:45 and 16:30.




