- Year 13 mock examinations Tuesday 26 November and end on Tuesday 10 December.
- Art Photography students have their exam on Friday 13 December.
- Morning exams begin at 09.00 and afternoon exams at 13.30 BUT students should ensure they are outside their allocated exam room at least 15 mins before the start time of their exams to enable the invigilators to advise students of the exam rules & regulations before the exam begins.
- Seating lists for each exam will be displayed on the exams noticeboard in the Sixth Form café at St Aidan's and in the Collins entrance at St John Fisher at least 24 hours before each exam and outside the exam hall/room on the day of exams. All exams (with just the exception of Music Technology) will take place at St Aidan's.
- Students should ensure they have their ID lanyards for all exams.
- Students should ensure they bring all the equipment they will need in a clear pencil case/plastic bag (eg black pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, mathematical equipment & calculator). We only have a limited supply of calculators available and these are primarily for students whose own equipment fails during an exam. Students should therefore ensure they check whether a calculator will be required for their exams with their Subject Teachers prior to their exam date. Calculators with data storage capability should be put into "Exam Mode" prior to your exam starting.
- Water bottles are permitted but these need to be clear bottles with all labels removed.
- Any coats & bags with mobile phones, airpods, watches etc should be left in the room signposted in the huts by CGH and this will then be locked during the exam.
- If any student is unwell on the day of their exam they must inform the Sixth Form Office at St Aidan's as early as possible
