

Research has shown that EPQ students have an increased chance of achieving an A*-B at A-level and are more likely to obtain a 1st or 2:1 at university. The EPQ is also invaluable for those applying for an Apprenticeship or entering workplace. Your EPQ study would start in the final half term of Year 12 and the completed project is handed in during the Spring term of Year 13, well before your final A Level exams.
