- Y12s Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

Do you have an interest you'd like to explore further or would you like to extend your learning beyond one of your A-level subjects? If so, the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) could be for you. Worth half an A-level and counting towards UCAS points, having an EPQ will help you to stand out from the crowd. Many universities will give lower A-level offers to students with an EPQ. Research has shown that EPQ students have an increased chance of achieving an A*—B at A-level and are more likely to obtain a 1st or 2:1 at university. The EPQ is also invaluable for those applying for an Apprenticeship or to entering workplace, as it will give you lots to talk about at an interview and can demonstrate to the company your high level of interest in their area of business. Your EPQ study would start in the final half term of Year 12 and the completed project is handed in during the Spring term of Y13, well before your final A Level exams.
